Parables & Proverbs

Where
there is no revelation,
the people cast off restraint;
But happy is he
who keeps the law
Proverbs 29:18

The famine is over...Joseph is dead, and the new Pharaoh is fearful of Joseph's family, the Israelites.

He sees them growing and become mighty with each passing day. Pharaoh's fears spike out of control, and he decrees,

"Kill all Hebrew male babies NOW before they decide to turn against me!"

Murder is upon the doorposts of all Hebrew homes that have expectant mothers. But in one home, a brave mother hides her baby boy in a basket, sending him down the river in faith. As she watches him float away, she looks up to heaven with tears in her eyes, trusting that God would continue to spare him against the wrath of the most powerful king in the world.

Suddenly, the basket splashes in front of the princess of Egypt. She reaches down and gently opens it up. Her heart is moved with compassion and love for the sweet innocence of this lost baby boy. She sees it's a Hebrew baby, but she doesn't care; her heart is somehow knitted to his. She runs to her daddy to tell him of the great treasure she has just found. He hesitates, but then looks to his daughter's heart. She is so happy; she has already given the child a name... Moses. And so, the king relents, and a prince is born.

Moses soon learns from his "daddy" the ways of his throne and enjoys the freedom and privilege of living in royalty. He sees the Hebrews enslaved by his father, but he thinks nothing of it. They are just his servants making his dad's kingdom look good. But as time goes on, restlessness in Moses' heart stirs this pursuing thought; *"I have been told I came from those Hebrews that are slaves to my dad. I wonder what they are like?"* Compelled one day by his curiosity, Moses sets off from the palace to see for himself.

In search of answers, his journey leads him face to face with an Egyptian taskmaster beating a Hebrew slave. A bolt of revelation rips his heart open, "I've got to do something! That's just not right!"

Exodus 2:11-12 "Now it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out to his brethren and looked at their burdens. And he saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew, one of his brethren. So he looked this way and that way, and when he saw no one, he killed the Egyptian and hid him in the sand."

A revelation from God can crucify an apathetic heart to shift into action with the Lord's compassion. However, only time with the Father will carry that revelation forward in His way, His timing, and His heart! The story of Moses sheds some light on this truth that will help us in 2012.

Moses was moved with the revelation of

how the Hebrew slaves were suffering wrongfully. Taking things into his own hands seemed so natural to Moses because he had learned this behavior from his adopted father. Pharaoh wrote the rules that governed Egypt that would best serve his kingdom. He could also determine what was right and wrong; and he could take life and pardon life at his word. So in witnessing the injustice of his father's cruelty toward the slaves, Moses was NOT restrained from his actions. Moses did what he felt was his only option; take control and be their god of deliverance!

It didn't take long for Moses to be confronted with the truth: his intention to come to the Hebrews defense to deliver them from evil was no more righteous than Pharaoh....

Exodus 2:13-14 "And when he went out the second day, behold, two Hebrew men were fighting, and he said to the one who did the wrong, 'Why are you striking your companion?' Then he said, 'Who made you a prince and judge over us? Do you intend to kill me as you killed the Egyptian?' So Moses feared and said, 'Surely this thing is known!'"


Not only had Moses defied his father's law, he will later find out that he defied God's law in the midst of trying to fix the wrong. In addition, he had now put himself at war with his dad. (Christians

find themselves today engaged in a battle because their behavior mimics our culture and not our Fathers!)

Exposed, he fled from his "father" Pharaoh and took refuge in the wilderness, only to discover his true "Abba Father." God speaks to him and identifies who He is and who are His people.

Exodus 3:6 "Moreover He said, 'I am the God of your father-the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.' And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God."

It is a humbling thought that only God decides when to open our eyes to His revelation. We are not in control of that! I am sure that Moses didn't plan on his day's journey to see the Hebrews any more than fieldtrip! But Deuteronomy 29:29 confirms that all of man's efforts cannot open someone's eyes to His truth. That job is God's. *"The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law."* Our job comes after God has opened our hearts to His revelation; to run to Him and understand His purpose of how He wants us to share what He has given us. As we spend more time with God, we then walk out His instruction in His heart and manner!



God tells Moses that he is going to be used to deliver the Hebrews bound in Pharaoh's slavery. God sends Moses back to Pharaoh with His word, His instruction, and His plan. BUT this time moving into action, Moses is out of the driver's seat and into the passenger's seat, a place not familiar to him considering the culture Moses grew up with. Moses would have to exercise a new muscle; trusting in God to be in control!

Spending time with God changed Moses' identity and character. It gave him the boldness to face going against the royal family who raised him and a government that could kill him. He did not appease Pharaoh and find a way to make peace with him. He did not back down because the request upset Pharaoh. He did not compromise! He had such an awesome reverential fear of God that produced a boldness to face the evil force that would come up against him and not back down from his position.

You would think GOD would find a way to make things easy for Moses to complete his mission. But He doesn't! God hardens Pharaoh's heart not to listen to him. I think God does this for two reasons:

One (1) was to show His signs and wonders to Pharaoh and the Gentiles so they had an opportunity to see who the one true God was.

The Second (2) was to re-establish Himself as God in the eyes of His covenanted people, the Hebrews! This included Moses! (Remember, the Egyptian culture had many gods! And God's people had been suppressed in that culture. The rich heritage that had been sown into them through their ancestors, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob had faded amongst the seemingly endless oppression.)

Pharaoh retaliates and makes it harder for the children of Israel by doubling their workload. The Hebrews are mad at Moses! So Moses runs to God and asks Him, WHY ARE YOUR OWN PEOPLE TURNING THEIR BACKS ON ME? (Has it ever gotten harder for you when you have stepped out in obedience to what God asked you to do?) And God answers Him:

Exodus 6:5-8 "And I have also heard the groaning of the children of Israel whom the Egyptians

keep in bondage; and I have remembered My covenant. Therefore say unto the children of Israel; I AM THE LORD; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm, and with great judgments; I will take you as My people, and I will be to you a God. Then you shall know that I AM THE LORD YOUR GOD, who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. And I will bring you into the land, which I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and to Jacob; and I will give it you for an heritage; I AM THE LORD."

God first identifies Himself again as **I AM!** Moses needed to be reassured! He even repeats this point because Moses hadn't quite developed his muscle in trusting in HIM ALONE! God secondly reminds Moses of His plan of redemption that re-fuels Moses and his purpose. Moses could have been crushed by popular opinion and the gigantic negative circumstances had he not continued to go back to God for answers and reassurance!

So, why is the story of Moses relevant today going into 2012? Never before in our history has our nation needed to glean from the leadership of Moses so leaders can step up and out in obedience and establish a pillar of influence and righteousness for Him. And it is His time to do it in 2012.

After the children of Israel were in the wilderness for 40 years, learning about their God, and receiving His law and His leadership through Moses, God instructed Moses to anoint Joshua to take the children of Israel into the Promised Land. **Joshua had served Moses and humbled himself to learn from his leadership. It was said of Joshua that He was "full of the Spirit of wisdom." (Deuteronomy 34:9) He had a mindset of faith and trust in the one true God.** After Moses died, Joshua obediently followed Moses' instructions.

It has been said by many that this next generation is the **"Joshua Generation"** God has equipped this generation with His Spirit through the revelation of the sacrifice of Jesus and the gift of the Holy Spirit, but we MUST also put on our armor of His law and His heart if we are going to conquer this land for His Kingdom!

God has already confirmed what He is doing today through His Word, (read Ezekiel 37), and through our news headlines as we witness Christians and Jews slowing and surprisingly find themselves united against evil. The Jews understand His law; the Christians understand His Spirit! We will need each other in the days ahead!!!

Our greatest mistake as Christians was to believe in the thought that once "born again" through the sacrifice of Jesus, the old covenant was null and void because we are **"saved by grace!"** However, Jesus Himself told us that He did not come here to abolish the law, but to fulfill it!! (Matt 5:17) Together with His law and His Spirit, we can find hope as a nation under God again!

God is releasing revelation to His people of the ungodly foundations our culture has adopted filled with compromise and works promoting self instead of His glory, building "pyramids" instead of communities. We are being compelled to act to what we now see! But moving forward to build His Kingdom, we will not see one man, one church, or one nation standing alone in this battle, nor elevated to power. Every nation and every saint will advance in His truth together because we all have one heartbeat; HIS!

Moses was comfortable in his palace, living amongst the comforts of the culture with his allegiance to the father of the world. But his heritage and his destiny called him out to save a nation of people instead of looking the other way. It took Moses time getting to know the Father, but Moses made history in the end!

the ready bride

“After this I looked, and there before me was a door standing open in heaven. And the voice I had first heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, ‘Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this.’”

(Revelation 4:1)

Revelation 4:1 invites John the apostle to come up to a higher level; to go through the open door and see what must take place in the future.

The painting in this article is one that was inspired by this verse and has inspired the words written in this article. This is an invitation for you to come up higher with your “Bridegroom,” to uncover the secrets of His Kingdom for you!

Christians have a destiny ordained by God from the beginning of time. Our destinies are designed to advance the Kingdom of Heaven here on earth. Jesus came to establish His Kingdom; our role is to collaborate with Him to advance it here on earth. The process of discovering the role we play in His Kingdom includes going deeper with God to receive revelation of what will take place, and to discover the plans He has for each one of us. The revelation of the role we play in advancing the Kingdom is revealed as we ascend to higher levels of intimacy with God and gain an understanding of His heart.

In Revelation 3:20 the Lord extends an invitation to the church of Laodicea which I think is for all of us:

“Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me.” (Revelation 3:20)

The Lord is again extending an invitation to come to that door, and now in this passage, He is knocking and waiting for us to come to eat with Him and hear the secrets of His heart. Going through the door is important! The door is an invitation to get closer to Him and receive what He has in store for us.

The parable of the ten virgins in Matthew 25:1-13 is a perfect description of the Kingdom of Heaven and the different types of believers. Some will go through the door, and others will not.

“At that time the Kingdom of Heaven will be like ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. ² Five of them were foolish and five were wise. ³ The foolish ones took their lamps but did not take any oil with them. ⁴ The wise ones, however, took oil in jars along with their lamps. ⁵ The bridegroom was a long time in coming, and they all became drowsy and fell asleep. ⁶ At midnight the cry rang out: ‘Here’s the bridegroom! Come out to meet him!’ ⁷ Then all the virgins woke up and trimmed their lamps. ⁸ The foolish ones said to the wise, ‘Give us some of your oil; our lamps are going out.’ ⁹ ‘No,’ they replied, ‘there may not be enough for both us and you. Instead, go to those who sell oil and buy some for yourselves.’ ¹⁰ But while they were on their way to buy the oil, the bridegroom arrived. The virgins who were ready went in with him to the wedding banquet. And the door was shut. ¹¹ Later the others also came. ‘Lord, Lord,’ they said, ‘Open the door for us!’ ¹² But he replied, ‘Truly I tell you, I don’t know you.’ ¹³ Therefore, keep watch, because you do not know the day or the hour.” (Matthew 25:1-13)

The two groups of virgin were very similar. They both knew the Bridegroom, they knew of His coming, and they both had lamps. The difference was the presence of oil in their lamps. The wise virgins had oil in which speaks of the presence of the Spirit touching their hearts as they spent time with God. The foolish ones were unprepared and had no oil. This is not a question of salvation because they expected Him and knew of Him but they missed the opportunity to be used in the Kingdom because they did not understand His purposes and were not intimate with Him. The foolish brides had no intimate knowledge of God.

In verse 10 we see the door being shut and the Lord telling them that He does not know them. The Hebrew word meaning "know" found in this parable is equivalent to Strong's #3045 YADA.

This word "know" in Hebrew is created by three Hebrew letters. The yud, the dalet, and the ayin. The yud is a picture of a hand or arm. The dalet is the picture of a door or opening, and the ayin is the picture of an eye or enlightening. We see the connection of knowing God and an open door for revelation through His Word!

This is the same word used by Paul when it speaks of the knowledge of Christ:

"What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage that I may gain Christ." (Philippians 3:8)

Similar to the wise virgins in the parable, this painting reveals a wise bride that knows how to go up higher and get the revelation needed to advance the Kingdom. She is extending her hand, holding the keys to the mystery of the heart of God that will give her access to revelation of an intimate encounter with the King.

Knowledge of God and Kingdom manifestation here on earth go hand in hand. Peter was given the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven because he knew by revelation that Jesus was the Messiah.

"I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be^d bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be^e loosed in heaven." (Matthew 16:19)

The bride has made herself ready!!!! She is ready to discover the secrets of her destiny so she can collaborate with her Bridegroom bringing the Kingdom of Heaven to Earth.

The King is knocking at the door of our heart to invite us to dine with Him.

All that is needed is to be ready and prepared for the encounter. I invite you to come up to a higher level with your Bridegroom to open the door and dine with Him. When your heart is transformed by the face-to-face encounter and knowledge of His glory, you will be covered by His peace and you will start advancing and releasing His kingdom here on earth. Do not delay!!!

We have probably been taught about some of the Bible's mysteries, but rarely do we hear about the Mystery of God. Scripture tells us that "It is the glory of God to conceal a matter, but the glory of kings is to search out a matter" (Pro. 25:2 NLT; Rev. 1:6, 5:10)

There are only about thirty-five places in scripture that speak of a "mystery" or "mysteries." If we add to these passages the scriptures that talk about things that are "hidden," that number increases. Today we are living in a time where more the hidden things of God are being revealed.

Like most people I have always loved a good mystery. So, many decades ago, while reading Scripture, I came across Daniel, chapter 12. Reading about the last days was fascinating yet I was astonished when I read verse 4: "But you, Daniel, shut up the words [of the prophecy given in verses 1-3], and seal the book until the time of the end; many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase." Are you kidding? The man whom, from his youth, Abba had used to interpret dreams and visions; the man who had been counselor to four kings, was not going to be given the interpretation—the meaning—of this prophecy!? **Why, Lord?**

Daniel is then given more information about the last days and he seeks to understand, "My Lord, what shall be the end of these things?" (vs. 8) But he is told, "Go your way, Daniel, for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end" (vs. 9).

Then again, Daniel is given even more information and told once more "But you, go your way till the end; for you shall rest [die], and will arise to your inheritance at the end of the days" (vs. 13).

Now, even as a youth in the spirit, I had learned that when the Lord repeats something it is really, really important. Here was a real mystery—not only what was meant by this

but also what happened to the sealed book? One thing I did know was that if Abba would not give the meaning of the information to Daniel, a man He loved so much that He repeatedly called him by his name (rather than son of man or something else like that), then the meaning could only be understood by revelation by the Holy Spirit.

Then one day I was reading in **The Revelation of Jesus Christ written by John the beloved who had been sent to the Isle of Patmos** [not much more than a barren rock in the middle of the sea], after he had been preserved from death when he had been boiled in oil [according to such authors as Tertullian, and John Fox]. This is the John who rested his head on Jesus' breast at the last supper before Jesus' passion; the one to whom Jesus entrusted the welfare of His mother; one of Jesus' three best friends! In chapter ten, I discovered Daniel's sealed book!

This book (and its information) was so precious that a mighty angel that came down from heaven held it. This angel was so large that he was able to plant one foot in the sea [Mediterranean] and one on the land [the isle]. His voice was so loud it sounded like a lion's roar and caused seven thunders [seven distinct warnings] to sound. John the Beloved started to write the warnings down but was instructed by Abba: "Seal up the things which the seven thunders uttered, and do

not write them down" (vs. 4c). WOW! Now, this really is a mystery—but it continues. It is so important that I am going to print the entire passage, verses 5-7:

“The angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land raised his hand to heaven [see Dan. 12:7] and swore by Him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there should be delay no longer, but in the days of the sounding of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, the **MYSTERY OF GOD** would be finished, as He declared to His servants the prophets.”

To complete this mystery we read in chapter 11, **verse 15:** “Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, ‘The kingdoms of this [natural] world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!’”

What does all this mean? Few mature believers would deny that we are at the very end of this present age, about to move in to the Kingdom age. We have probably heard a plethora of sermons on the “last days,” but the truth is that until six trumpets [messages] have sounded, and immediately before the seventh and FINAL trumpet [message] is sounded, this mystery has never been correctly, clearly preached because Abba has had it sealed up! (John was instructed to not seal up the prophecy of the revelation of Jesus the Christ, but was instructed to seal up the Mystery of God, which would only be revealed by the Spirit before the last message goes forth. [Rev. 22:9-10].)

The question then becomes, “Do you want to know this mystery?” If you, like I did, want to discover the key that unlocks this Mystery of God, that was hidden down through multiple millennia, from Daniel and John the beloved alike, and is now ready to be revealed by the

Father, then you have an assignment.

This assignment isn't difficult but it is time consuming; depending upon the time you have available, and your hunger, it can take anywhere from one week to more than a month. (It took me two weeks because I spent about thirty-two hours over two weekends, as well as two to four hours nightly, but I went off on a lot of “bunny trails.”) Only those who really, really want to understand this Mystery will take the time to do the assignment. Not doing the assignment would be similar to trying to enter the sheepfold over the fence rather than through the gate, and it will be to your spiritual hurt.

By diligently doing the assignment, your eyes will be quickened to see what Abba has had hidden in His Word from the beginning. It's like when you get a new car, and then as you drive down the freeway you “see” many of the same cars. It wasn't that those cars suddenly appeared on the freeway at the same moment, it is that they were always there but your eyes were not yet opened to seeing them. Having eyes to see you did not see what was plainly there all the time! By the time you are halfway through the Bible the veil will have begun to fall off your eyes BUT do not stop....you need to see this Truth through the entire Bible!

What will it profit us if we do this assignment? First, it is a journey of discovering this mystery that Abba has hidden in His word through the ages...He didn't reveal it to Daniel nor John the Beloved, but now is the time He is revealing it to all those who have spiritual eyes and ears and a hunger to know Him as He knows us. Second, it will demonstrate Abba's heart and how He has been working throughout the ages to fulfill His covenant that He made with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Israel). Just as Scripture teaches there are believers who are thirty-fold and sixty-fold Christians, there are those who will do their assignment--the hundred-fold, Abba's portion--who, upon completion, will be filled with the joy of knowing and understanding the plan He established before the foundation of the earth.”
